



## THORNEYCROFT 1½ TON PARCEL VAN

A parcel delivery van widely used in the 1920's and 1930's, many were still on the road at the start of the Second World War. The Great Western Railway operated this type of vehicle in some numbers with G.W.R. Brown and Cream as normal livery. Advertising posters were sometimes displayed on the upper side panel behind the G.W.R. logo. Rated maximum speed of the vehicle was 12 m.p.h.

All parts should be cleaned of flashing where necessary and a "dry run" done before cementing. Liquid cements are recommended (e.g. Slaters "Mekpak", Britfix "Poly 70" etc. etc.)



Colour scheme:  
 Cream - above panelled side  
 Brown - panelled side, inside cab, bonnet, front panel, chassis, wheels, headlight bracket  
 Matt black - tyres, axles, radiator  
 Silver - radiator surround, headlights.


